

# 21 DAYS OF PRAYER & FASTING



**Jan 3 - Renewal** - Renewed hunger to be connected to God, His Word His People, and His purposes in our lives.

**Jan 4 - His Presence** - Pray God creates a more profound desire to experience and spend time in His presence. In His presence is freedom, divine wisdom, renewed strength and power to live in the victory of Christ.

**Jan 5 - Stewardship** - Ask God to help us all steward the relationships, resources of time, finances, and words with eternity at the forefront.

**Jan 18 - Spiritual Formation** - We pray God would grow each of us to be like Him.

**Jan 19 - Staff Marriages** - Pray for deep love, for each other, their children and their church.

**Jan 20 - Global Missions** - Pray that God will protect, guide, and grant favor to the missionaries we support around the globe.

**Jan 21 - The Favor of God** - May God in 2025 bestow unusual favor on our jobs, and occupations. May we find favor and blessing in all we put our hands to knowing that as we obey God He will abundantly supply resources beyond what we can imagine.
