01 Abide

AUGUST 8

We pray to be a church that always prioritizes abiding and remaining in the presence of Jesus. Priorities constantly shift, yet this is the greatest action we can take. God is not looking for busy people — He is looking for open and available ones.

AUGUST 9

May God help our hearts always defer to You as supreme in every situation and every area of our lives. Help us walk humbly, love mercy, and reflect Your heart in how we treat people.

03 Spiritual Formation

AUGUST 10

Help us not merely attend or show up for spiritual activity, but let Christlike formation become a deep desire of our hearts.

04 Righteousness

AUGUST 11

May the righteousness freely given to us in Christ shape how we see ourselves, and how God our Father sees us.

05 Embrace Repentance

AUGUST 12
